







We can use the possessive form of nouns with people or groups of people (e.g. companies), other living things, places, and times. To make the possessive form of names ending in -s (pronounced /z/) we can add either ' or 's:

- It's Derek **Jones'** (or Derek **Jones's**) new sports car.

Even if the last letter of the author's name is an s, then still put an 's. Exceptions: non-English surnames that end in a silent -s (e.g. *Camus' first novel, Descartes' meditations*).
