

Types of conditional	Rules for remembering
(Onditional () real actions	<u>If +Present Simple, Present simple /real actions/</u> E.g. If you <u>have</u> a chance, <u>do</u> it.
Conditional 1 real action	<u>If+ Present Simple, will+Verb1</u> E.g. If we <u>eat</u> a lot chocolate, we <u>will get</u> fat very soon.
Conditional 2 unreal action	<u>If +Past Simple, would/could/ might+Verb1</u> E.g. If they <u>had a car they could go</u> there driving it.
Conditional 3 unreal action in the past	If +Past Perfect, would/could/might/ have+V3 E.g. If they <u>hadn't lost</u> their money, they <u>would have bought</u> that.
