

CONDITIONALS

Types of conditional	Rules for remembering
Conditional 0 real actions	<u>If +Present Simple, Present simple /real actions/</u> E.g. If you <u>have</u> a chance, <u>do</u> it.
Conditional 1 real action	<u>If+ Present Simple, will+Verb1</u> E.g. If we <u>eat</u> a lot chocolate, we <u>will get</u> fat very soon.
Conditional 2 unreal action	<u>If +Past Simple, would/could/ might+Verb1</u> E.g. If they <u>had</u> a car they <u>could go</u> there driving it.
Conditional 3 unreal action in the past	<u>If +Past Perfect, would /could/ might/ have+V3</u> E.g. If they <u>hadn't lost</u> their money, they <u>would have bought</u> that.

If you **heat** water to 100°C, it **boils**.

PrS (V1 / Vs - do/does)

Type 1 Conditionals – real future

If you **come** earlier, we **will go** for a walk.

PrS (V1 / Vs - do/does)

FS (will V)

Type 2 Conditionals – unreal present/future

If I **were** you, I **would go** to the dentist.

PS (V2 - (did))

F-in the past-S (would V)

Type 3 Conditionals – unreal past

If I **had studied** harder, I **would have had** a "5".

PP (had V3)

F-in the past-P (would have V3)

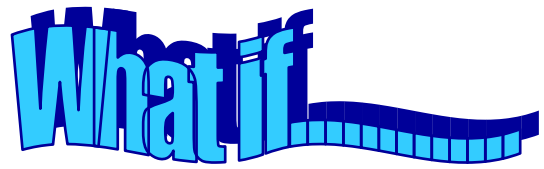
