Complex Subject

Noun/Pronoun + Predicate + Infinitive

The combination of a noun in the common case (or a pronoun in the nominative case) and an infinitive forms a **complex subject** (1).

The predicate which is usually expressed by a verb in the <u>passive voice</u> is placed between the noun and the infinitive. The relation between the noun and the infinitive is that of subject and predicate.

Note 1: - According to another interpretation the subject is expressed by a noun or pronoun and the infinitive is regarded as a part of the predicate.

Key examples:

- He is said to be a good teacher.
- The boy is known to have passed his exams well.

The predicate in sentences with a complex subject can be expressed by:

1. The same verbs that can be followed by a <u>complex object</u> (that is verbs of sense perception: *to see, to hear...*, verbs of mental activity: *to know, to suppose...*; verbs of inducement: *to order, to cause, to allow...*,). The verbs are used in the passive voice.
