
Lesson 10-Containers-Grammar (part 2)



Exercise 1



B any and some in questions

In most questions (but not all) we use any:

- Is there any ice in the fridge?
- Has he got any friends?
- Do you need any help?

We normally use **some** (not **any**) when we offer things (**Would you like** ...?):

A: Would you like some coffee?
B: Yes, please.

or when we ask for things (Can I have ... ? etc.):

- A: Can I have some soup, please?
 - B: Yes. Help yourself.
- A: Can you lend me some money?
- B: Sure. How much do you need?





not (n't) + any

- There aren't any cars in the car park.
- Sally and Steve haven't got any children.
- You can have some coffee but I don't want any.

no + noun (no cars / no garden etc.) no ... = not + any or not + a:

- There are no cars in the car park. (= there aren't any cars)
- We've got no coffee. (= we haven't got any coffee)
- It's a nice house but there's no garden. (= there isn't a garden)

There are **no** cars } in the car park.
