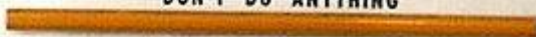

I. Watch the video and answer the questions.

II. Watch a short film, predict how the film will end, speak about the film.

Step 1. Write the following sentences on the board.

- I'm like my brother.
- My brother and I are alike.

Explain that two sentences mean the same thing, but that *like* followed by another person, *alike* goes at the end of a sentence.

Step 2. Ask your students to describe character of their members of family. Then ask them to tell about themselves and a member of their family using *like* or *alike*.

Step 3. Tell your students they are going to watch a short film about a father and his son. They should notice in what ways the father and son, and their lives are alike.
