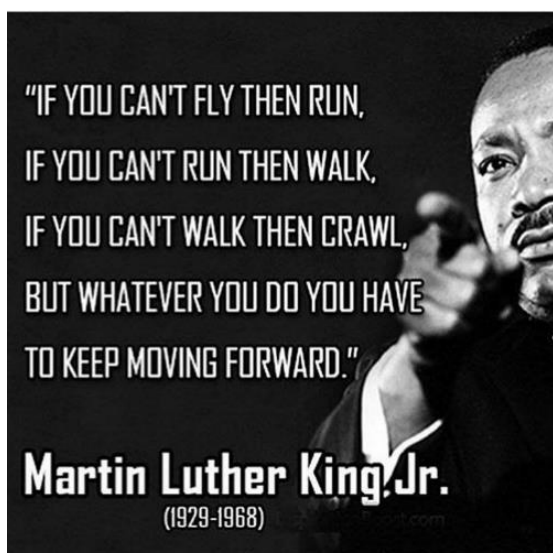


Conditional Sentences

- **Present real conditionals :**
If /when + present tense / modal
○ *Water boils if it reaches 100°*
- **Present or future real conditional :**
If/unless + present,..... Future
○ *If I study, I'll pass*
- **Present unreal conditionals:**
If + past,would +inf.
○ *If I studied, I would pass*
- **Past unreal conditionals :**
If + past perfect would have + pp
○ *If I had studied, I would have passed*
