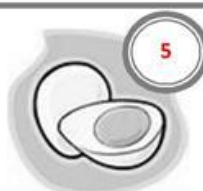
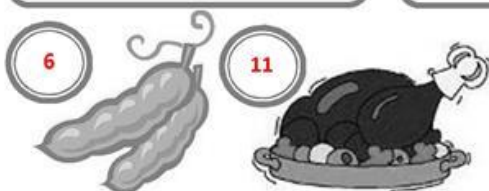
Exercise 2.

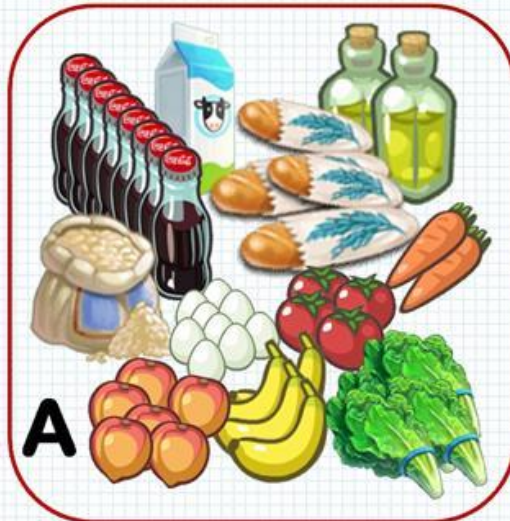
- 1- **Pick** some apples from the tree.
